The Product Development Technician will be responsible for documenting processes and providing feedback and ideas to improve sample/product manufacturability and processability and will be responsible for executing scale-up activities to production. The Product Development Technician must have a focus in quality to ensure the highest level of customer satisfaction and will be required to test physical properties and evaluate the visual appearance of samples. This position will include both lab-scale and production-scale sample preparation.
